Beneficiaries:

2.24 million people in six countries (Indonesia, Sri Lanka, Somalia, Myanmar, Maldives and Thailand) received food aid at the peak of the operation

WFP also provided supplementary food rations to:

138,000 pregnant women, nursing mothers and children under 5 to tackle

malnutrition

450,000 primary school children to encourage them to return to class

50,000 people who rebuilt roads, bridges and homes in exchange for food

Logistics

210,000 metric tons of food aid were moved by land, sea and air

WFP aircraft flew over 40,000 aid workers, donors and journalists around the

tsunami zone

Funds

US\$273 million donated (WFP appealed for \$274 million for food and logistics

operations)

US\$215 million ? or 80 percent ? spent in less than 12 months

WFP purchased close to 100,000 tons of food locally, helping boost local

markets in Sri Lanka and Indonesia.

Food aid operations in tsunami-affected areas in 2006-2007
Indonesia 1.2 million people will receive food rations, school
feeding or
maternal and child nutrition assistance over the next two years, at a
cost
of US\$88 million
Sri Lanka 347,000 people affected by the tsunami will benefit from
food aid
under WFP's programme for 1 million poor women, children and other
groups at
risk of malnutrition people; the programme will cost US\$37 million.
