Beirut bakers have begun making bread from wheatflour from the World Food Programme for distribution to the tens of thousands of people who have flooded into Beirut from the south and other parts of the country affected by the month-old conflict between Hizbullah and the Israeli Defence Forces. WFP has so far delivered more than 20 tons of flour to bakers in Beirut. The bread will be distributed the the municipal authorities and NGOs to IDPs packed into public parks, schools and other buildings all over the city.
