

WFP SHOTLIST RMAICH 17 AUGUST 2006-08-17

STORYLINE: WFP delivers its first aid convoy to the south of Lebanon after the declaration of the ceasefire on 14 August. This convoy, which reached Tyre on Monday 14 August and Rmaich on the border with Israel the following day, was the first UN convoy to the south in more than a week. The supplies – wheat flour, meat, water, medical supplies etc. – were offloaded in both Tyre and Rmaich and distributed by the municipal authorities and the Lebanese Red Cross. The aid delivered to Rmaich is for 7,000 people for a month and is being given not just to the inhabitants of Rmaich (which was not badly shelled) but also to inhabitants of surrounding villages, some of which were badly hit. One, Aaita ech Chaab (just before Rmaich), was almost completely flattened by Israeli shelling.
