The United Nations-African Union Mission in Darfur (UNAMID) conducts an initial verification mission to assess the security and humanitarian situation in the area which was reportedly subject to aerial bombardment on 4, May 2008.

"Darfur right now is a totally lawless region. And therefore I am very very concerned about the safety of our staff and all the humanitarian workers working in Dafur. It is not only the trucks that get attacked. We have staff moving around in cars, NGOs moving in the camps and all of them are very, very vulnerable. You never know when they may get attacked. So security is definitely the mean concern in Darfur right now."
