Storyline: On 26 August to 1 September, United Nations World Food Programme (WFP) Asia Regional Director Tony Banbury travelled to five provinces in the Democratic People's Republic of Korea: Ryanggang, North Hamgyong, South Hamgyong, Kangwon and Pyongyang. Banbury visited hospitals, nurseries, orphanages and kindergartens receiving WFP food assistance and inspected WFP food commodities in public distribution centers, local food production factories and county warehouses. He also held meetings with government officials in the capital Pyongyang and in the provinces and counties to discuss the implementation of the WFP programme and the need for food assistance.
